

# Summer 2021/2022 Domestic Season

TABA would like to announce that team entries for the upcoming 2021/2022 Summer Season have now opened for both junior and senior competitions. The 2021/2022 season will commence on the 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021 and end in April 2022.

## TEAM REGISTRATION PROCESS

All team registrations MUST be completed ONLINE via [www.playhq.com](http://www.playhq.com)

Team entries close on **Friday 10th September 2021** and late entries may not be accepted.

## PLAYER REGISTRATION PROCESS

All players are required to register into their team using the player to team link which is generated when the team is registered by the team contact. Please use your existing PlayHQ account to register you and/or your child to their teams. If you do not have an account you can create one upon registering to the team.

All players MUST be registered and paid before Round 1. Upon registration, PlayHQ will require payment of all fees applicable. There are no exceptions to this process.

## FEES

All fees are payable upon player to team registration. PlayHQ will not finalise the registration without the payment. The TABA office will not accept EFTPOS or cash payments and therefore all registrations and payments MUST be done in PlayHQ prior round 1.

The fees applicable are:

- TABA Registration Fee's: Senior = \$80.00, Junior = \$70.00, Under 8 = \$50.00
- Basketball Victorian Licence Fee Junior (365 day = \$25.00, Senior = \$39.00

*\*PlayHQ will calculate the BV Licence fee and apply it to the amount charged if you are required to pay/renew it. You must use the same PlayHQ profile previously created for it to recognise any fees due and payable.*

## COVID 19 Statement

In response to the COVID 19 pandemic, TABA acknowledge that our competitions and programs may vary without notice, including the loss of rounds played, alterations to season configuration and in extreme cases the cancellation of seasons/programs. TABA are committed to working through these variations with the goal of getting athletes back on the court in alignment with government advice.

Upfront fees will remain in place to allow TABA to continue to plan and run each season/program as per normal.



Should the pandemic significantly effect the running of a season or program, the TABA Board will assess the situation and the eligibility of athlete refunds or credit vouchers, however in general all requests for refunds will be assessed as per the current refund policy requirements.

### **UNDER 16 & 18 GIRLS COMPETITION**

To enable longevity, retention rates and development in the Girls A grade domestic U16/U18 competition, the previous format will remain the same as the previous 2 seasons.

This season, TABA will facilitate the A grade domestic competition in both these age groups. B Grade will remain the same as previous seasons and teams can enter independently.

To participate in either the Girls Under 16 and or under 18 A grade competition, please fill in the Cognito form via the link below.

Once teams are finalised all athletes will receive the relevant PlayHQ player to team registration link to register into to their allocated team.

Registrations will close on the 10th September 2021 at 5:00pm.

### **UNDER 8's COMPETITION & REGISTRATION PROCESS**

Children born in 2015 and 2016 are eligible to register for the Under 8's competition. The Under 8's program is organised by TABA so you do not need to register a team you just need to register your child. Registrations will open on the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 and must be completed via [www.PlayHQ.com](http://www.PlayHQ.com) when the link is opened.

The season will commence on the 8<sup>th</sup> October 2021 and run through to April 2022.

Aussie Hoops is an introductory program into basketball and aimed for 5-10 year old's.

Registrations for the Term 4 Aussie Hoops will be open towards the end of September and the program will commence in October.

The program is run on Friday afternoon at the Gippsland Indoor Regional Sports Stadium.

## FORFEITS

All teams that forfeit without giving TABA 24 hours' notice will be required to pay a forfeit fee of \$30. 2nd and subsequent forfeits incur a fee of \$50. This payment is required to be paid to the TABA office prior to taking the court for the team's next game. ## FINALS QUALIFICATION

Players are required to play half the number of available games scheduled plus one to qualify for finals. Byes do not count as available games. Players failing to meet finals eligibility requirements must complete a Request for Special Permission to Qualify for Finals form which must be received by NO LATER THAN (2) WEEKS prior to the commencement of finals. Any forms received after this time may not be considered. Unregistered or ineligible players participating in a game may result in the match being
