NOMINATION AND SELECTION:

All nominations received will be reviewed by the Board and if required, assistance will be obtained from the Director of Coaching and the Squad Coordinator. The selection of the award winner by the Board will be final.

CRITERIA:

Nominees must have made a significant contribution in the field of coaching. This includes but is not limited to:

- Coaching at a domestic level.
- Coaching at a representative level.
- Actively pursuing self-development in coaching.
- Actively pursuing player development.
- Actively pursuing development of assistant coaches.
- Regular attendance at training sessions.
- Regular attendance at games.
- Keeping abreast with rule changes and new coaching methods.
