



FRAN HAMMOND AWARD

FOR EXCELLENCE BY A TABA MEMBER IN THEIR CHOSEN DISCIPLINE

PREAMBLE:

This award is named for Fran Hammond who was a member of the Traralgon Amateur Basketball Association, who went on to represent Victoria and Australia as a player and a Team Captain.

This award is not an annual award. It will only be granted when in the opinion of the TABA Board, a member of the Association has achieved a standard of excellence in their chosen field.

NOMINATION AND SELECTION:

Nominations for the “Fran Hammond Award” will be accepted from any financial member of the Association on the form provided for this purpose. All nominations received will be reviewed by the Board and, if required assistance will be obtained from current and active Life Members and other governing bodies to confirm or support the eligibility of the candidate. The selection of the award winner by the Board will be final.

CRITERIA:

Nominees must have achieved a standard of excellence in their chosen field. Some examples but not limited to:

- Selected to play in the National Basketball League or Women’s National Basketball League.
- Selection to represent Australia as a player.
- Selection as a Coach or Assistant Coach of a National Team.
- Selection as a Team Manager of a National Team.
- Selection as a Technical Official at an International Competition.
