



KAYE HART AWARD

“MOST OUTSTANDING TABA REFEREE”

PREAMBLE:

This award is named for Kaye Hart who was a member of the Traralgon Amateur Basketball Association, who excelled in the field of refereeing. Kaye was the first TABA referee to attain an Australian Badge, to referee at a national level, to become an affiliated referee coach and TABA's first Jack Terrill medallist.

This award will be granted to a referee who has excelled in their field of endeavour.

NOMINATION AND SELECTION:

Nominations for the “Kaye Hart Award” will be accepted from any financial member of the association on the form provided for this purpose. All nominations received will be reviewed by the Board, and if required, assistance will be obtained from current and active Life Members and other governing bodies to confirm or support the eligibility of candidates. The selection of the award winner by the Board will be final.

CRITERIA:

Nominees must have achieved a standard of excellence in their chosen field. Some examples are, but not limited to:

- Achieving a level 1A or higher grading.
- Being selected to attend a National Event.
- Being selected to officiate on BV Junior Panel.
- Being selected to officiate at Big V competitions.
- Becoming an affiliated referee coach.
