

TABA LIFE MEMBER AWARD

PREAMBLE:

Life Membership of the Traralgon Amateur Basketball Association is the highest honour that can be bestowed by its members and as such, all prospective nominees must have attained a degree of excellence and a high level of commitment to and participation in the Association.

NOMINATION AND SELECTION:

Nominations for Life Membership of TABA will be accepted from any financial member of the Association on the form provided for this purpose. Not all nominees will be granted a Life Membership.

All nominations will be reviewed by a panel consisting of three (3) current and acting Life Members within the Association and two (2) current Board Members. The recommendations of the panel will then be taken to the Board and will be voted on.

This will be awarded either at the AGM or a special event prior to the AGM.

CRITERIA:

- <u>Category 1:</u> All nominees are to have attained a degree of excellence and a high level of Commitment to and Participation in TABA for a minimum of ten (10) years. **This Category is Mandatory**.
- <u>Category 2:</u> Played at a Representative Level for a minimum of five (5) years.
- <u>Category 3:</u> Coached at a domestic and or Representative level for a minimum of five (5) years.
- <u>Category 4:</u> Key Board Portfolio holder for a minimum of five (5) years.
- <u>Category 5:</u> Refereed at a domestic and representative level for a minimum five (5) years.

- <u>Category 6:</u> Manager at a Representative level for a minimum five (5) years.
- <u>Category 7:</u> Made personal contributions of undoubted and significant benefits to TABA for a minimum five (5) years.

RULES FOR CONSIDERATION:

There are 7 categories as shown above, any candidate <u>MUST</u> have Category 1 to be considered.

To continue the Nominee must qualify in another 3 categories to be eligible.

The above criteria are not automatic grounds for granting a Life Membership, however to assist in determining the candidate's nomination the following steps are to be taken.

Step 1. Convene a panel as above.

Step 2. Consideration should be given to a comparison of existing Life Members achievements.

Step 3. If required, existing Life Members comments and opinions can be considered.
